
Have you been looking forward to shrugging off the winter blues with longer days, warmer weather, and new things to do? Here are a few things we have happening:

Print of Place is an exhibition by Dianne Strahan exploring a lifelong love affair with plants, and the slow making process of botanical printing. Her works are often highly site specific, in some cases road specific. Each telling the story of somewhere she has been, and each bringing back memories of her travels through WA with her husband Steve.

Sense of Country: Ned Crossley

19 November - 11 December

This exhibition is Ned's first offering in oil paints, made in the months since taking a wonderful trip late last year out east of Esperance through the fringes of the Great Western Woodland and Cape Arid National Park. Ned has augmented images of these places with some scenes from Dryandra Woodland and his own country (Knotwood) and hope they convey some sense of the spirit that abides in these natural landscapes.

This exhibition is supported by the inaugural enRICH scholarship, funded by local donations to the Arts Narrogin Incorporated Gift Fund.


